RULES OF THE DULWICH HAMLET FC 1893 CLUB

The Purpose

The Dulwich Hamlet Football Club 1893 Club ("the 1893 Club") is a lottery intended to provide funds for the benefit of Dulwich Hamlet Football Club and the uses of which will be determined by the contributors to the lottery.

Legal Status

The 1893 Club is registered with the London Borough of Southwark Council as a Society Lottery, and will operate under The Gambling Act 2005 and the Small Society Lotteries (Registration of Non-Commercial Societies) Regulations 2007.

According to legislation, the maximum value of tickets sold under by the 1893 Club in a single lottery will be £20,000 or less and the aggregate value of the tickets put on sale in a calendar year will be £250,000 or less.

The value of a single ticket (or "chance") will be £1.

Under the Gambling Act 2005 the maximum global amount that can be deducted for expenses and prizes remains at 80%, with the remaining 20% or more going to the purposes of the society or to local authority expenditure.

Expenses incurred (other than for prizes) will be kept to a minimum. All expenses incurred (even when covered by donations) will be recorded and be available for inspection by any contributor who so requests.

Details of draws will be lodged with the London Borough of Southwark as required by legislation.

Operation

The Promoter of the 1893 Club will be Paul Griffin, afterwards referred to as the Promoter.

Alliance and Leicester Commercial Bank are the Bankers for the 1893 Club with Paul Griffin (Promoter) and Jack Payne (Chairman of Dulwich Hamlet Football Club) as signatories.

A subscriber will be required to complete a monthly Bank Standing Order in favour of the 1893 Club to the value of an exact number of pounds and to send the Standing Order form to the Promoter. Standing Orders will not be implemented until a minimum level of subscription has been reached.

reached. The minimum level will be £50 per month thus enabling the first draw to be made as soon as possible.

Once the minimum subscription level has been reached, the Promoter will notify all subscribers that payments under their Standing Orders will begin at a convenient date in the next four weeks, and will send the relevant forms to DHFC's bank, having completed the date section of the form appropriately. The Promoter will also announce that draws will begin two weeks after the initial payment date.

To reduce costs, physical tickets will not be issued to subscribers. Instead, a list of subscribers to each draw and the numbers allocated to them will be available for examination by subscribers before each draw is conducted and published on the 1893 Club Website.

One draw will be conducted per month, so long as contributions remain above 75% of the minimum subscription level. When contributions drop below this level, the 1893 Club and all associated Standing Orders will be suspended. If contributions remain below 75% of the Minimum subscription level for three months, the 1893 Club will be closed.

Draws will be conducted at Dulwich Hamlet home matches, with the results published on the official Dulwich Hamlet website, on the 1893 Club website/blog, on the unofficial message board, in match day programmes at home games and announced over the PA at home games.

There will be three cash prizes in each draw as follows 1st Prize = £30% of prize pool; 2nd Prize = 15% and 3rd Prize = 5%.

Distribution of Profits

The profits of the 1893 Club will be used to the benefit of Dulwich Hamlet Football Club, the destination of said funds to be determined by consensus of contributors.

Should the 1893 Club be wound up, all profits remaining after the repayment to subscribers of monies which have not yet purchased tickets in draws will be redistributed to subscribers allocated on a percentage contribution to previous draws unless individual contributors wish otherwise.
